Agape Children's Home

- Established in 1957
- Also called "i-ro i-ro"(いろいろ), means **"All Kinds" of children in the children's home**
- Taking care of children who had lived in dysfunctional families such as, being abandoned or abused, ...etc. and helping them have an appropriate education and development.

2 houses for boys (Home of Faith, Home of Hope)

2 houses for girls (Home of Noah, Home of Love)

Caretaking & Upbringing

- To set regular daily routine for children in each home
- To cultivate children good habits and to teach them how to take care of themselves
- To educate children how to use pocket money, to cultivate them correct concept of finance
- To arrange the leisure time for children
- To develop the relationship between hometeachers and children through valuable talking time









Schooling & Tutoring

- To communicate with schools for understanding the school performance of each child
- To tutor children's homework; and to guide children's study







Skill Learning

- To explore children's talent and arrange talent courses for them in order to develop children's self-confidence
- Talent courses: playing piano, guitar, drums, and Chinese yoyo;
 blowing harmonica; skating, singing, dancing, and painting; writing classes, etc.



Independence Ability Cultivation

- To offer children &youth career counseling / career training
- To provide children &youth independence ability training / finance management
- To open up internship / career skill training / career exploration to children &youth
- To enhance children &youth's ability of dealing with crises



For more than 60 years, Agape Children's Home has protected the children, even during rain and storms...

Agape Children's Home

Total Served 3,489 people

Takes care of those children who have lived in dysfunctional families. Helping them have an appropriate education and development.



Group Home

Total Served 20 people

Based on children's different needs. Provides small familylike residency in communities.



Mustard Youth Home

Total Served 1,512 people

Provides a caring and loving environment for young people who have been in family crisis and have lived in dysfunctional families.





Pei-Hsin Home
Total Served 112 people

Provides youth a shortterm care service, secure residence and counseling services. To help them have a stable life and develop their own life goals, in order to safeguard their rights and have a well-developed purpose.





Mustard Seed Kindergarten

Last Academic Year: 193 people

Teaching children to have Good Character and a Positive Learning Attitude. So they will have healthy physical and spiritual development.

Vocational Training Center

Total Served 2,417 people

Provides youth between ages of 15-20, and women with financial pressure, to have Career Counseling and Training in terms of social enterprise working model.





Family Service Center

Total Served 2,684 people

Provides services for the vulnerable children and families in Fuxing District of Taoyuan City, Taiwan

Child Protection Family Maintenance Service Program

Community Elderly Service

Sponsorship for Children in Poverty (Taiwan)
